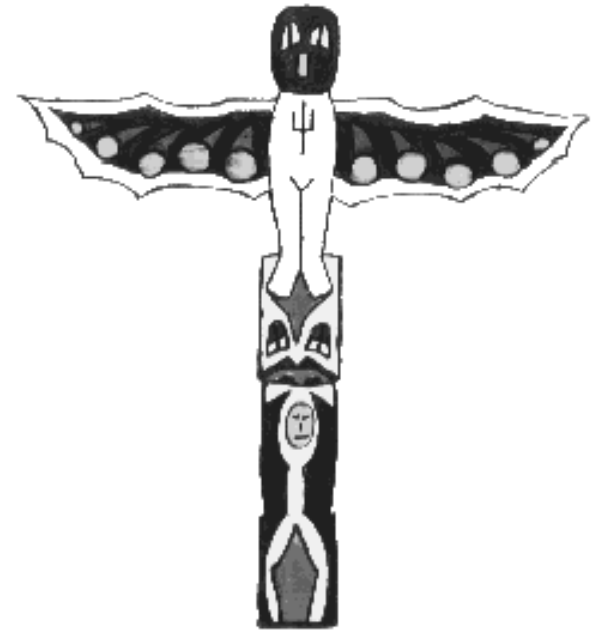

General

The Haliburton Scout Reserve Alumni Association exists to provide former staff members of the Haliburton Scout Reserve with a sense of ongoing fellowship, camp news and history by linking past and present members, while promoting service to the camp.

Activities are conducted throughout each year, both social and service oriented. Members are encouraged to participate in whatever activities for which they are available. For the majority of members who live outside the Toronto area (including the U.S. and Europe) our newsletter, the Alumni Thunderbird, is your link to the Alumni.

Alumni Thunderbird

Published three times a year (fall, winter & spring), our newsletter is mailed to all members-in-good-standing providing us with a forum for sharing information with former staff members, announcing Alumni activities and service projects, and remembering our summers at HSR. Contributions are always welcome.

Alumni Social Events

Throughout the year, the Alumni tries to provide the means and activities to get together socially. Our two major annual activities are Alumni Weekend and Pub Night.

Alumni Weekend is held annually at HSR on the first weekend after the Civic holiday in August. Many activities for the Alumni and their guests are held throughout the weekend including the infamous steak BBQ and, of course, the Annual Staff vs. Alumni Cricket Match. Guest sites are held for Alumni use, are and available on a first come first served basis. A nominal fee is charged to cover the costs associated with meals and accommodation.

Pub Night is held in downtown Toronto, usually right between Christmas and New Years. We provide some munchies and the venue for our members to catch up in a relaxed atmosphere. This event is free to current members, and at a nominal price for guests.

An annual Trails Weekend serves as both a social event and a service project.

Other events including Golf and Mini-Golf Tournaments as well as a Bowling Night have also been offered in the past and may be offered again in future where there is want. These types of activities are advertised well in advance in both the Alumni Thunderbird (newsletter) and on the Alumni web page. Everyone is welcome to come out, and we appreciate anyone bringing a new face to these events whenever possible.

Service

The Alumni are currently involved in service projects for the camp.

The Association helps to maintain the system of hiking trails both on and off the camp property. A Trials Weekend is held every fall at the camp to work on maintaining the trails.

The Archive display presented in Kennabi Lodge is organized, constructed and maintained by the Alumni Association. Any archive materials would be gratefully accepted.

Alumni Executive

The executive is comprised of the following positions: Co-Chairs (2), Secretary, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, Archive Chair, Social Chair, Bursary Chair, Membership Chair and Member-at-Large (2).

Any Alumni member in good standing can seek election to any of these positions. Elections are held each year at the Annual General Meeting. Executive Committee meetings are held throughout the year and any Alumni member is welcome to attend. Dates, times and locations for these meetings are available in the Thunderbird newsletter and on the Alumni web pages.

Volunteers are always welcome to attend meetings and to be a part of any committee.

Bursary

The HSR Staff Alumni Bursary is awarded annually to a current staff member of HSR who will be attending a post secondary education institution the following year and has shown a continuing contribution to the camp and/or Scouting in general.

The goal of the Bursary to help current HSR staff with the expense of education, and to assist in providing continuity and leadership Recipients will be announced at the annual Alumni Weekend.

The Bursary is funded by donations and special fund raising activities like the golf tournament, bowling night and from other monies designated by the Alumni Executive Committee. Donations are always welcome.
